AUTUMN IN THE SIERRAS

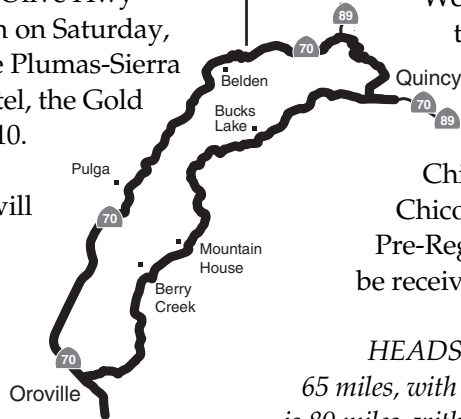
October 16 & 17, 2010

Enjoy autumn in the Sierras on this weekend of fabulous mountain road riding in Butte and Plumas Counties.

Riders will meet at Gold Country Casino, 4020 Olive Hwy (Hwy 162) in Oroville between 7:00 am and 9:00 am on Saturday, October 16th. A Sag Van will carry your bags to the Plumas-Sierra Fairgrounds if you're camping -- or to our host motel, the Gold Pan Lodge. Rooms must be reserved by Oct 1st, 2010. Call 1-800-804-6541 for reservations.

Dinner on Saturday and breakfast on Sunday will be up to you. Quincy is a full service tourist destination with ample choices for dining. Of course, cooking in camp is also an option.

Saturday's route is very steep and hilly, naturally, since you'll be crossing the crest of the Sierra-Nevada Range. Olive Hwy rolls along



Lake Oroville for the first few miles before beginning the big climbs to Berry Creek and Mountain House, then over the top and down to Buck's Lake/Haskin's Valley where you'll find stores and cafes. Drop through Meadow Valley and down into Quincy for a 65 mile day. Your bags will have been delivered to your predetermined lodging site.

On Sunday morning we'll pick up your bags and bring them back to Oroville. The return is via Hwy. 70, the Feather River Canyon. This beautiful route is mostly downhill -- with a tailwind if you get an early start. There is one gentle climb from Pulga to Jarbo Gap and the descent into Oroville. Total mileage is 80 miles.

We'll rent a few hotel rooms at the casino at the finish so riders can shower and clean up after the ride.

Fee is \$50.00 payable to Chico Velo, PO Box 2285, Chico, CA 95927.

Pre-Registration only, which must be received by October 14th, 2010.

HEADS UP: Day 1 is approximately 65 miles, with 8,000+ feet of climbing. Day 2 is 80 miles, with 2,000+ feet of climbing.

action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns as follows: (A) Waive, Release and Discharge from any and all liability for my death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to me or my traveling to and from this event, THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES OR PERSONS: Chico Velo Cycling Club, their directors, officers, employees, volunteers, representatives, and agents, the event holders, event sponsors, event directors, event volunteers; (B) Indemnify and Hold Harmless the entities or persons mentioned in this paragraph from any and all liabilities or claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of any of my actions during this event.

I hereby consent to receive medical treatment which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and or illness during this event.
