

EVENT WAIVER

I understand that by registering I have accepted and agreed to the waiver and release agreement(s) presented to me during registration and that these documents include a release of liability and waiver of legal rights and deprive me of the right to sue certain parties. By agreeing, I have acknowledged that I have both read and understood any waiver and release agreement(s) presented to me as part of the registration process and accept the inherent dangers and risks which may or may not be readily foreseeable, including without limitation personal injury, property damage or death that arise from participation in the event.

Statement of Risk: I acknowledge that this athletic event is an extreme test of a person's physical and mental limits and carries with it the potential for death, serious injury and property loss. The risks include, but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, weather, condition of athletes, equipment, vehicular traffic, actions of other people including, but not limited to, participants, volunteers, spectators, coaches, event officials, and event monitors, and/or producers of the event, and lack of hydration. These risks are not only inherent to athletics, but are also present for volunteers. I hereby assume all of the risks of participating &/or volunteering in this event. I realize that liability may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained or controlled by them or because of their possible liability without fault. I certify that I am physically fit, have sufficiently trained for participation in the event and have not been advised otherwise by a qualified medical person. I acknowledge that this Accident Waiver and Release of Liability (AWRL) form will be used by the event holders, sponsors and organizers, in which I may participate and that it will govern my actions and responsibilities at said events. In consideration of my application and permitting me to participate in this event, I hereby take action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns as follows: (A) Waive, Release and Discharge from any and all liability for my death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to me or my traveling to and from this event, THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES OR PERSONS: Chico Velo Cycling Club, their directors, officers, employees, volunteers, representatives, and agents, the event holders, event sponsors, event directors, event volunteers; (B) Indemnify and Hold Harmless the entities or persons mentioned in this paragraph from any and all liabilities or claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of any of my actions during this event. I hereby consent to receive medical treatment which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and or illness during this event. I understand that at this event or related activities, I may be photographed. I agree to allow my photo, video or film likeness to be used for any legitimate purpose by the event holders, producers, sponsors, organizers and or assigns. This AWRL shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law. I hereby certify that I have read this document; and, I understand its content. I WILL WEAR AN ANSI/SNELL APPROVED HELMET. The undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby represent that he/she is, in fact, acting in such capacity and agrees to save and hold harmless and indemnify each and all of the parties referred to above from all liability, loss, cost, claim or damage whatsoever which may be imposed upon said parties because of any defect in or lack of such capacity to so act and release said parties on behalf of the minor and the parents or legal guardian. All children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult.

Registration includes optional camping at the Fairgrounds on Friday night, luggage transportation, detailed route map, overnight accommodations at the Mattole Camp & Retreat Center, post-ride snacks, dinner on Saturday, breakfast on Sunday, SAG support...and plenty of fun! *We haul your gear, you just enjoy the scenery.*

WEEKEND OVERVIEW

Friday Night

Rider Check-In. Optional tent camping at the Fairgrounds. There are multiple dinner options in Ferndale and nearby Fortuna.

Saturday

In the morning, bring your gear to the Uhaul and grab a cup of coffee. There are a variety of great breakfast options in Ferndale and along your route. Post-ride snacks, sandwiches, and beverages will await you and dinner will be served by the Chico Velo crew.

Accommodations at the Mattole Camp & Retreat Center include indoor or outdoor options. Tent camp sites are on spacious grounds and are virtually unlimited or choose one of their cabins. Cabins have between 4 and 8 bunk beds, must be shared, are on a first-come, first-served basis and limited to 60 people total.

Sunday

An amazing locavore breakfast will be provided by the folks at the Mattole Grange Hall. Your gear will be awaiting you as you arrive to the Fairgrounds.

A WORD OF WARNING!

The climbs on this ride are challenging and there will be limited SAG support. The Wall is purported to be an average of 18% for 1.25 miles. Ouch! To enjoy this ride to its fullest, you should be in decent physical condition and self-sufficient. A triple or compact won't hurt either. Mechanic service is not available on this ride so **PLEASE** make sure your bike is in good working order.

COURSE

Saturday's 65 miles explores the Eel River Valley, then heads through the Avenue of the Giants, turning west into the Rockefeller Redwoods, where we'll have a water stop before the big climb up Panther Gap (2,744'). From there, it is all down to Honeydew where eight miles of rollers brings you to the Mattole Camp & Retreat Center on the Mattole River.

Sunday's ride of 35 miles goes through Petrolia, down the beach and up the legendary Wall (up to a 22% grade) of Cape Mendocino where we'll have a water stop. Once over the top, you drop down to Capetown, then up, up, up the Shadow of the Wall to Malfunction Junction. From there, you'll descend into Ferndale and the Fairgrounds where your belongings will be waiting for you with one of our SAG drivers.

START/FINISH

The ride begins and ends at the Humboldt County Fairgrounds in Ferndale (about 20 miles south of Eureka). Showers available at Start/Finish.
